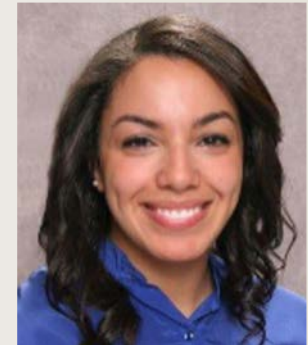

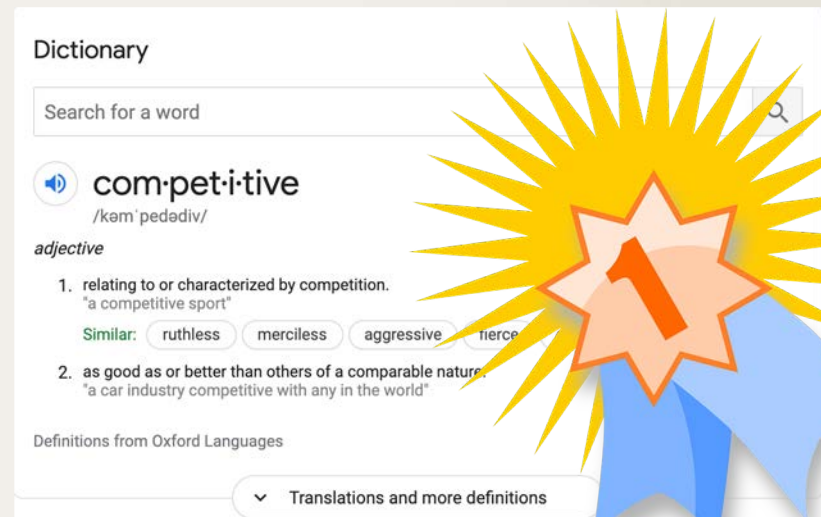

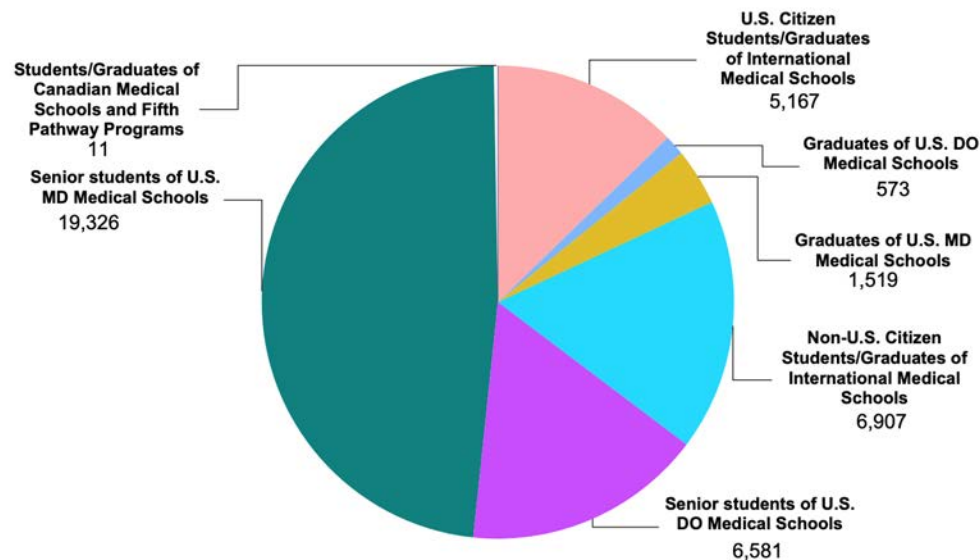
# Let's start off with the basics: what does it mean to be a competitive applicant?

- Competitiveness: a term that is used to determine what is a candidate's likelihood of matching into residency
- EM competitiveness is influenced through tangible factors such as grades, board scores, class rank, and letters of recommendation and can be qualified based on nationally available data
- It is important to note that competitiveness can also be broken down into national, regional, or locally competitive
  - For example, this can be important if you are an IMG or osteopathic candidate when searching for regions that have historically accepted such applicants

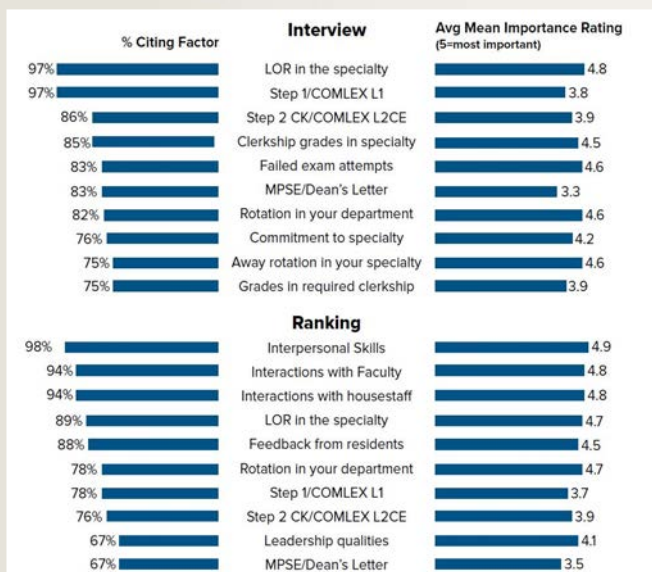
**Chart 1** Active Applicants in the 2020 Main Residency Match  
*by Applicant Type*



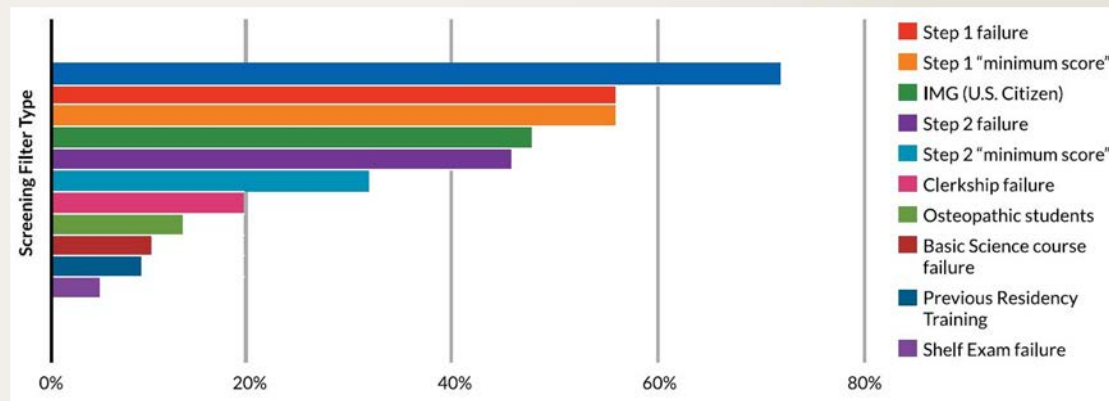


# What Factors Did PD's Consider To Be The Most Influential When Selecting a Candidate?

These are the factors cited as most important by PD's according to 2018 NRMP data



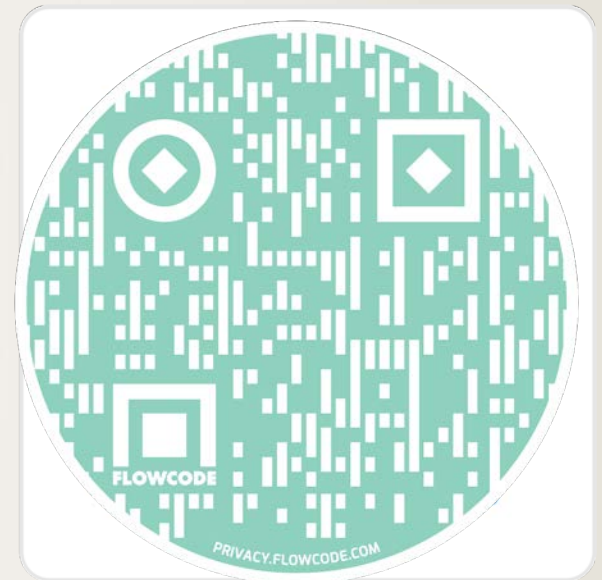

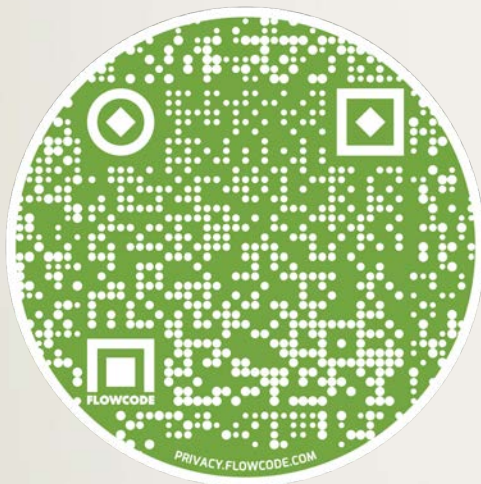

EM Match: 2020 By the Numbers

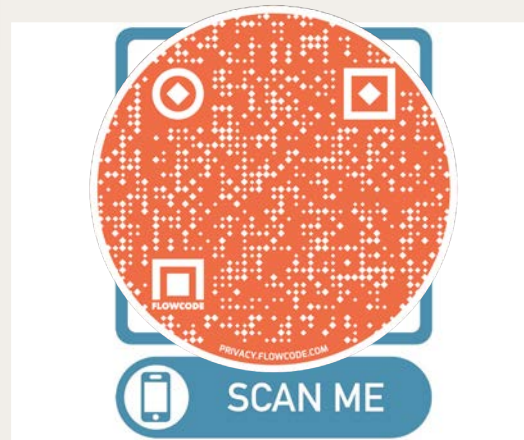

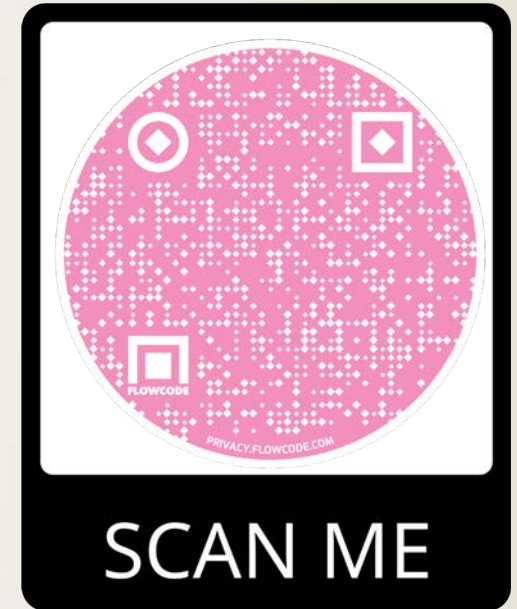
