1. Research Forum

Original research, performance improvement projects, and case reports are acceptable for submission. Abstracts should be no longer than 250 words in length and adhere to the formatting for below.

For original research and performance improvement projects, please structure the abstract with four sections: 1) Study Objectives, 2) Methods, 3) Results, and 4) Conclusions

For case reports, please provide a case summary.

2. Lecture competition

Please submit a written summary of the proposed topic (less than 250 words) and up to three written objectives for the lecture. Lectures slots will be 6-10 minutes depending on the number of submissions. Winner of the competition will receive a full lecture slot in the 2022 Government Services Symposium conference.
