

Let's start off with the basics: what does it mean to be a competitive applicant?

- Competitiveness: a term that is used to determine what is a candidate's likelihood of matching into residency
- EM competitiveness is influenced through tangible factors such as grades, board scores, class rank, and letters of recommendation and can be qualified based on nationally available data
- It is important to note that competitiveness can also be broken down into national, regional, or locally competitive
 - For example, this can be important
 if you are an IMG or osteopathic
 candidate when searching for
 regions that have historically
 accepted such applicants






























A Look at the Numbers: 2020 NRMP Match Information

































What Factors Did PD's Consider To Be The Most **Influential When Selecting a Candidate?**




